## **Cannes Optional Tours**

### **Tour 1:**

#### **Monaco, Monte Carlo, Eze, & La Turbie - Sightseeing Tour**

**\$100.00 per person – June 11, 2018 4 hours**

Description:

En route to Monaco, make the first stop to discover the medieval village of Eze, one of the most picturesque sites of the French Riviera. Dating from the Middle Ages, the village was built on top of the rocky outcrop for security reasons. The walls of the twelfth century were dismantled in 1706 by order of Louis XIV. Walk the cobbled streets and reach the top where you can find the exotic garden and the castle ruins. The view is amazing! Then, we will visit the famous Fragonard perfume factory down in the village. Next, we will go through the village of La Turbie, also called the "Monaco Terrace" because of the panoramic view of the Principality of Monaco. Admire the ruins of an imposing monument, the Trophy of the Alps, dedicated to the Emperor Augustus in 7 BC, on the road that linked Italy to Cimiez (the Roman Quarter Nice) long ago. Then, we will visit "Le Rocher" (the rock) which overlooks the sea and harbor of Monaco. From here, you will discover: The Prince's Palace and the Changing of the Guard at 11:55am. In front of the Palais du Prince, you will also notice the Carabinieri Barracks. Since their formation on the 8th of December, 1817, the Carabinieri have ensured the safety of the Royal Family as well as maintained public order. The

Cathedral of neo-Roman style, where the first stone was laid on the 6th of January, 1875. Entirely built in white stones from La Turbie, it was completed on the 12th of November 1903. You can pay tribute to the Monaco Princes and "Princesse Grace de Monaco" who rest here. You will also be able to see the Justice Palace and Oceanographic Museum. Finally, we will arrive in Monte-Carlo in the most beautiful way - by taking the famous Grand Prix track of Formula One. We will explore Monte-Carlo and discover The Casino de Monte-Carlo, whose construction was ordered by the Societe des Bains de Mer (created by Francois Blanc in 1863 ) and the plans were developed in 1878 by the famous architect Charles Garnier. You can also explore the lavish Casino gardens, and then we will visit the Hotel de Paris, which has all of the charm of the great hotels of the 19th Century

## **Tour 3:**

### **Grasse, Gourdon, Valbonne, & Wine Tasting - Sightseeing Tour**

**\$204.21 per person- 8 hours -June 13, 2018**

Description:

Towards the countryside, you will start your tour by Grasse. Discover how this city, once known for its production of leather, became the world's capital of perfume. Explore the old town and discover the famous Fragonard perfume factory with a guided tour. Then, head to Valbonne and stroll around in the cobbled streets of the medieval village, built in the sixteenth century under the direction of the monks of "Lrins" islands. Discover the village's crafts and cafes. Enjoy free time for lunch in a typical restaurant in the main square. Head upriver via "Le Loup" to access Gourdon, the "Eagle's Nest," which overlooks the valley atop a dizzying peak of 760 meters. You will be captivated by the views all over the Cote d'Azur. Browse the village streets between old restored houses and craft shops. Admire the castle built during the thirteenth century and restored in the seventeenth century. It is a rectangular building which exhibits several collections: ancient arms and armor, furniture from the seventeenth century, Aubusson tapestry, and sculptures. The gardens were designed by Le Ntre. On the way back, you will visit a winery located in the heart of the vineyard of Bellet, above Nice. The location offers an amazing view of the sea, and vines browsing the hills. A tasting of local wines will be offered.
